TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.6,08,270/- with interest at the rate
 of 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till the date of deposit and costs as

compensation. Challenging the quantum of compensation, the appellant/Insurance Company has preferred the present appeal.

2. After due deliberation and consultation, considering the facts and circumstances and also the award passed by the Tribunal, the appellant agreed to confirm the award amount passed by the Tribunal i.e., of Rs.6,08,270/- (Rupees Six Lakhs and Eight Thousand Two Hundred and Seventy Only). Accordingly, the award passed by the Tribunal is confirmed.

3. In view of the above, the appellant is directed to deposit the entire award amount after deducting the amount deposited, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this award. On such deposit, the respondents are entitled to withdraw the same with accrued interest thereon in the same ratio as apportioned by the Tribunal.

4. The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of accordingly. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition, if any, is closed.

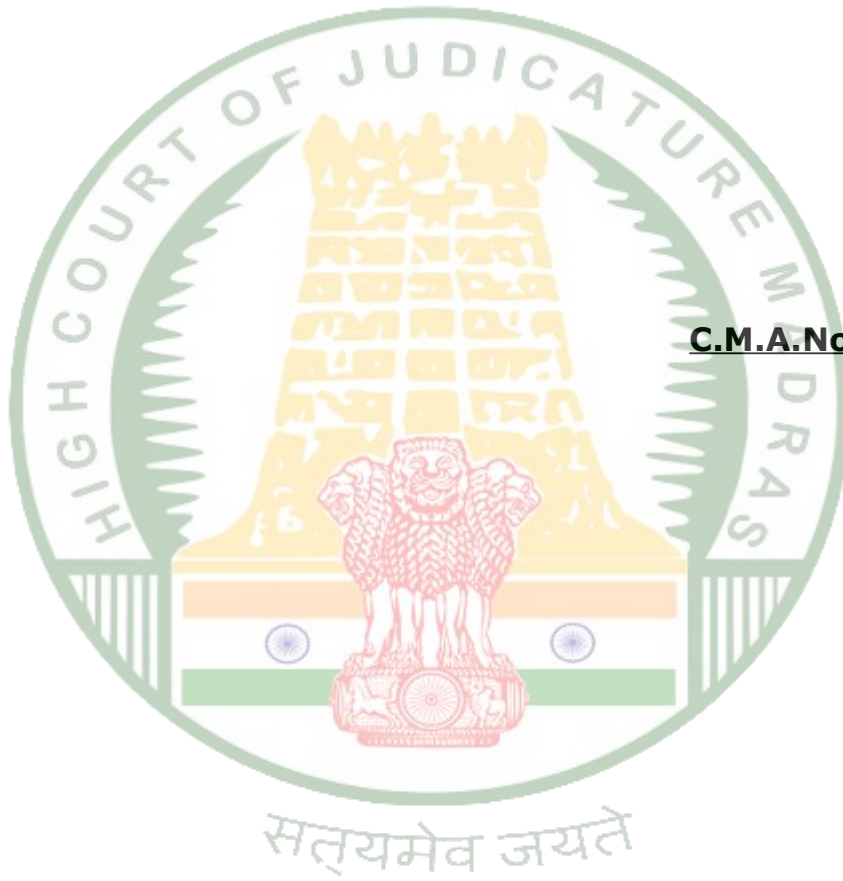
