ORDER

3. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 31.08.2018 to the first respondent seeking issuance of death certificate of her mother, namely, Kamatchi, W/o.Rajasekar, who died on 06.11.2009 and the said

representation has been forwarded to the second respondent for appropriate action, but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the second respondent. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. Heard Mr.M.Jothikumar, learned Additional Government Pleader on behalf of the respondents.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made on either side, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the representation, directs the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 31.08.2018 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after issuing notice to the petitioner and the persons interested in this regard and also affording them an opportunity of personal hearing, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above directions, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
