TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

Both the counsel are present with their respective parties.

2.The learned counsel for the first respondent/claimant submitted that as per the award passed by the Tribunal, the entire award amount with interest was already deposited before the Tribunal. Now, both the parties have agreed for the settlement that the appellant/Insurance Company will withdraw Rs.30,000/- from the deposited amount before the Tribunal. The first respondent/claimant will withdraw the balance amount with accrued interest. The award is passed in terms of the aforesaid settlement.

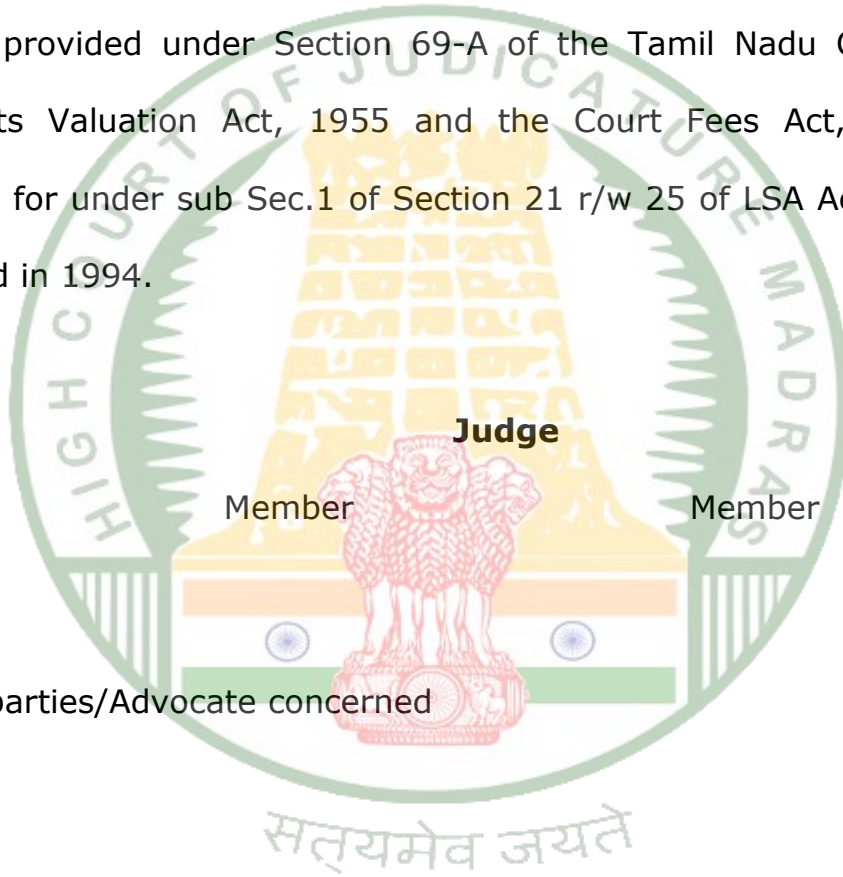
