### **TERMS OF SETTLEMENT**

Though the Insurance Company has taken up the plea regarding the liability in view of the recent judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court with reference to the endorsement made in the driving licence, the Insurance Company seeks permission of this Court to withdraw this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal and made an endorsement to that effect.

2. Hence, this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is dismissed as withdrawn. The claimants are permitted to withdraw the entire amount that has been deposited by the Insurance Company. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

This Lok Adalat award is passed in terms of the above settlement.

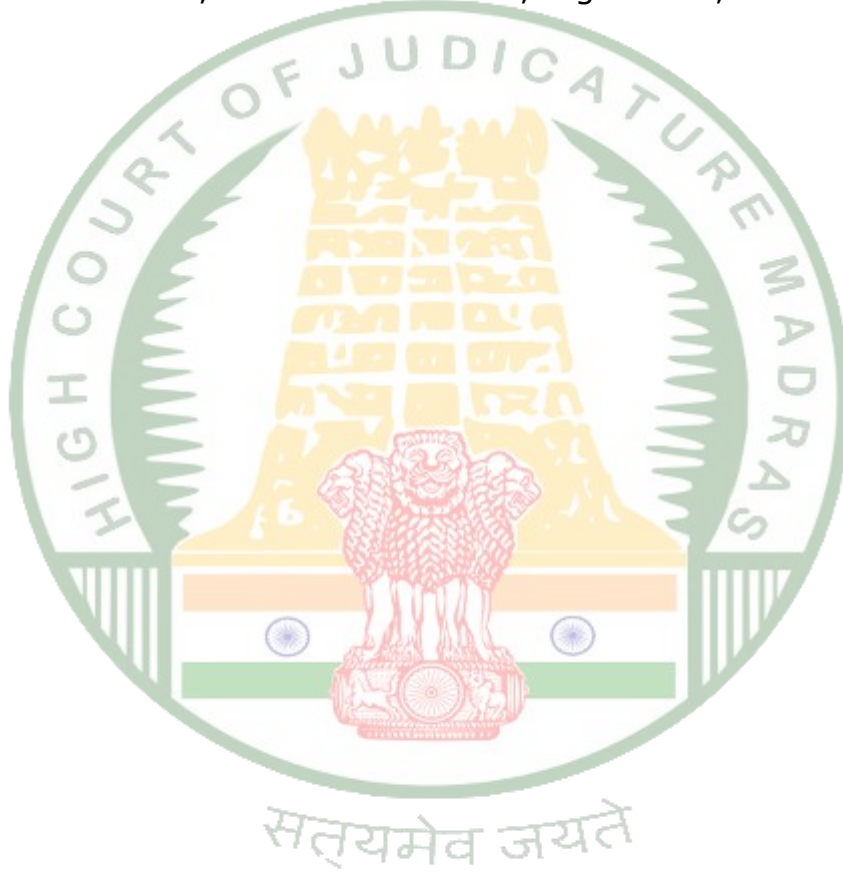

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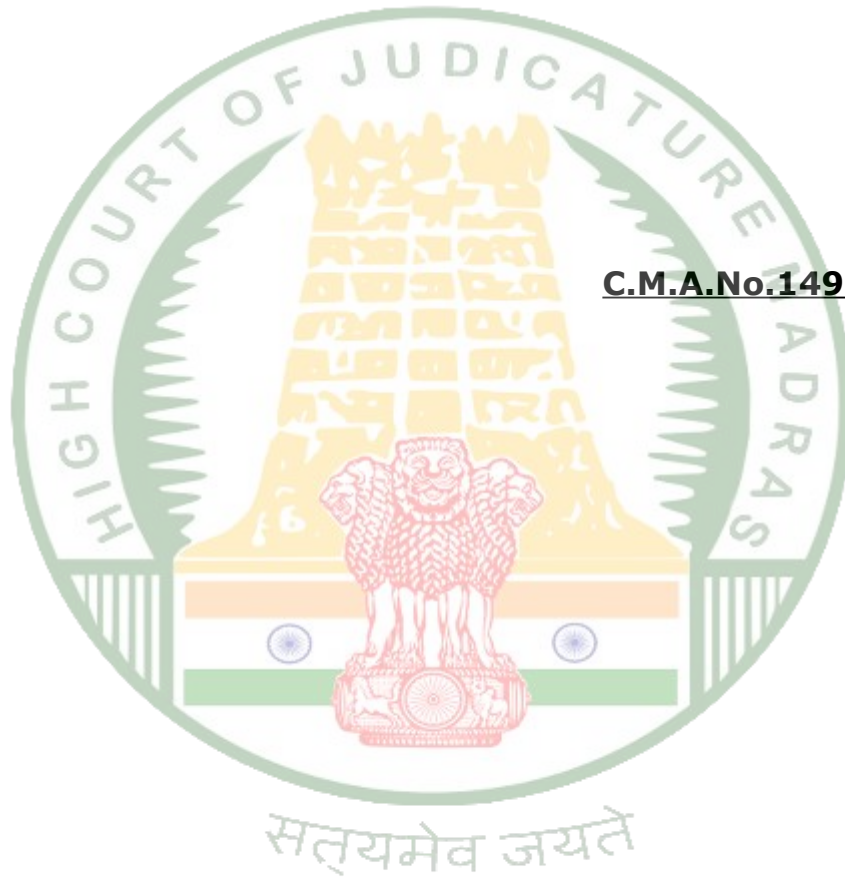
