Plaint under Order XXXIV Rule 1 of C.P.C read with Order XXXVII Rule I of O.S. Rules prays for a judgment and decree against the defendants jointly and severally (a) for a sum of Rs.2,41,00,000 together with further interest at 18% per annum from the date of filing of the suit till the date of payment (b) to pass a decree by directing the sale of the properties mortgaged in Schedule "A" if the defendants do not pay the amounts within the time fixed by this Court (c) If the sale proceeds of the sale of the properties mentioned in Schedule "A" are not sufficient to meet the outstanding amounts due to the plaintiff, to pass a personal decree against fourth defendant.

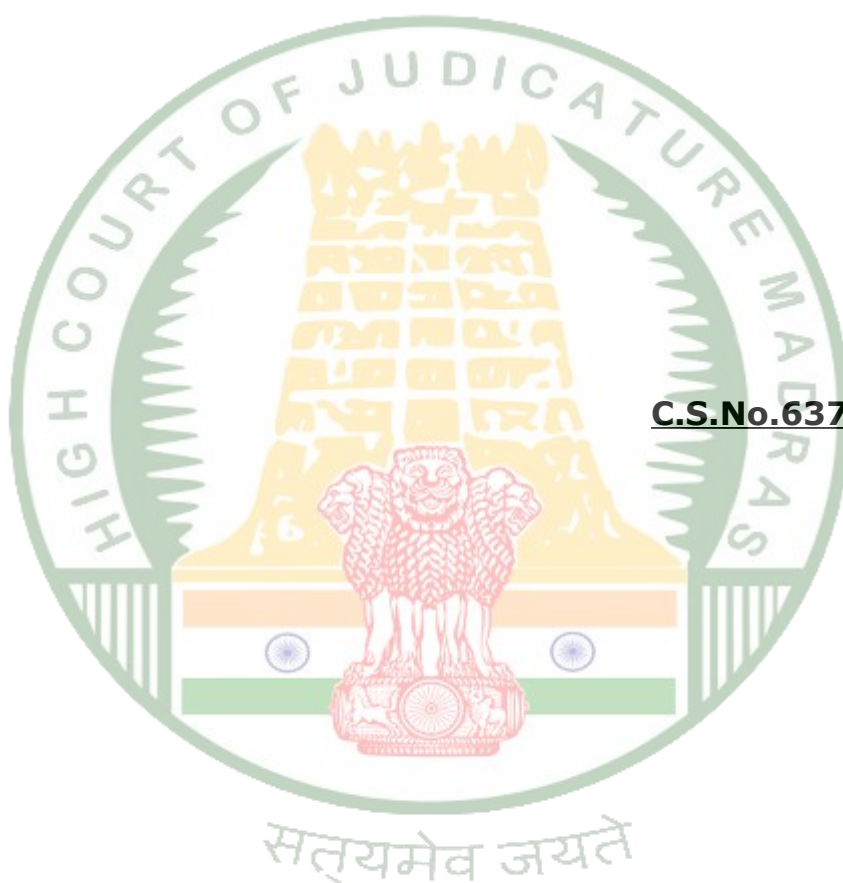
