Kalaiyarasan, S/o.Ezhilarasan, they are residing at Vellore. The detainee further informs that her parents i.e., the petitioner and his wife are problems to the detainee owing to her having entered upon an inter caste marriage. The petitioner as also his wife had been informed the said position.

Recording such statement, this Habeas Corpus Petition shall stand closed.

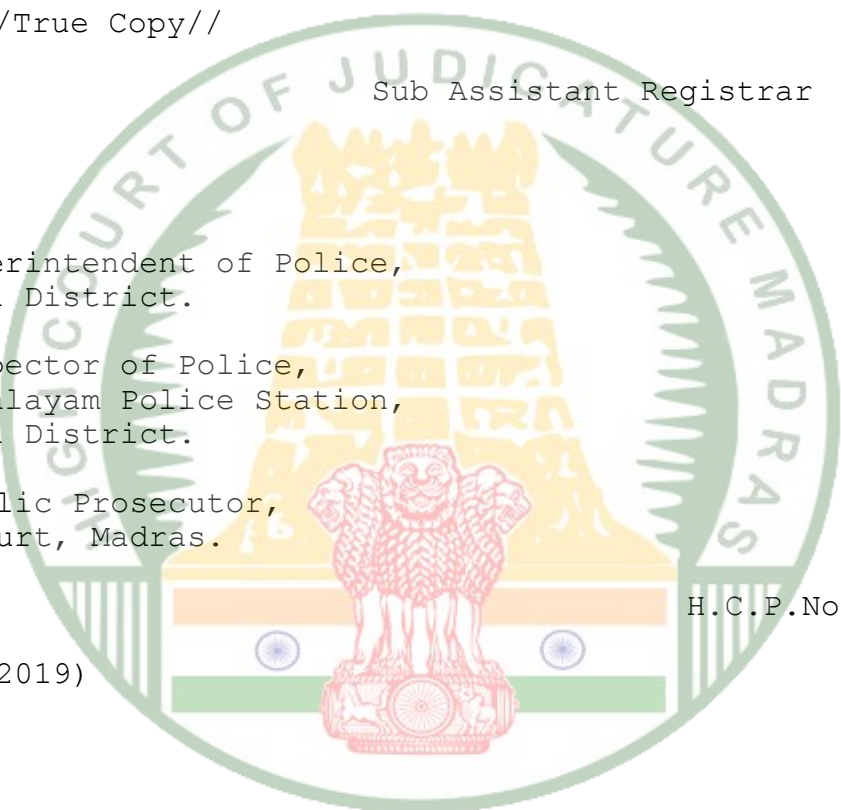
