ORDER

When the matter was listed for hearing on 12.11.2018, Mr.K.T.Sankar Subramanian, representing M/s.King & Partridge, appearing for the petitioner submitted that they already given change of Vakalat and handed over the papers to the petitioner-bank four years ago. dismissed for non prosecution. No costs.

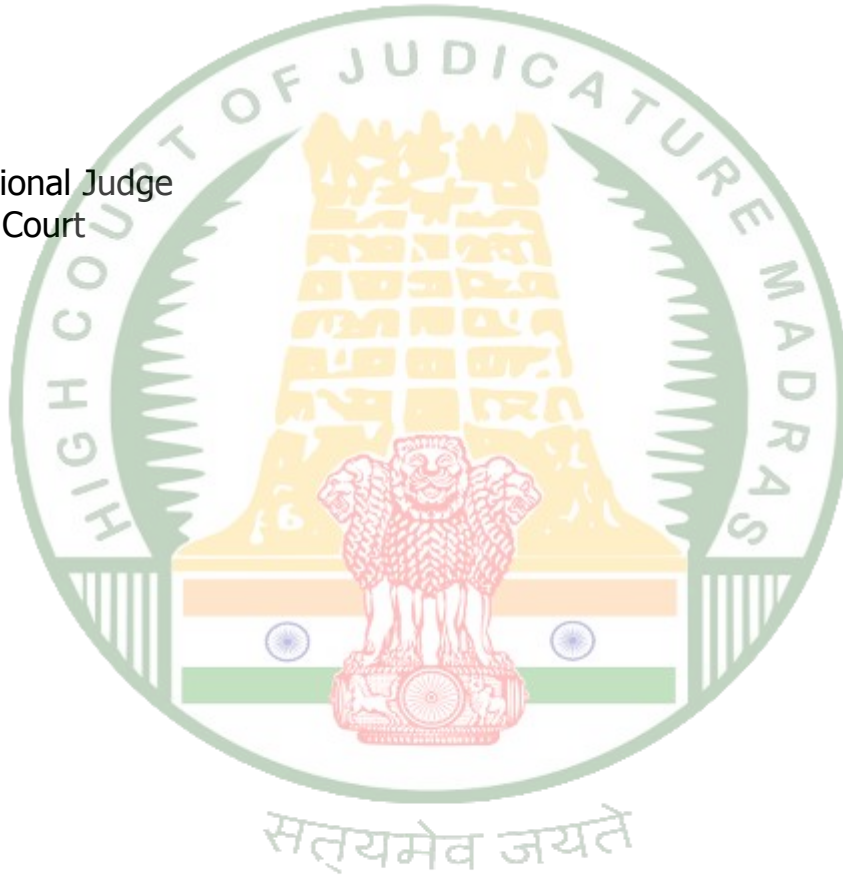

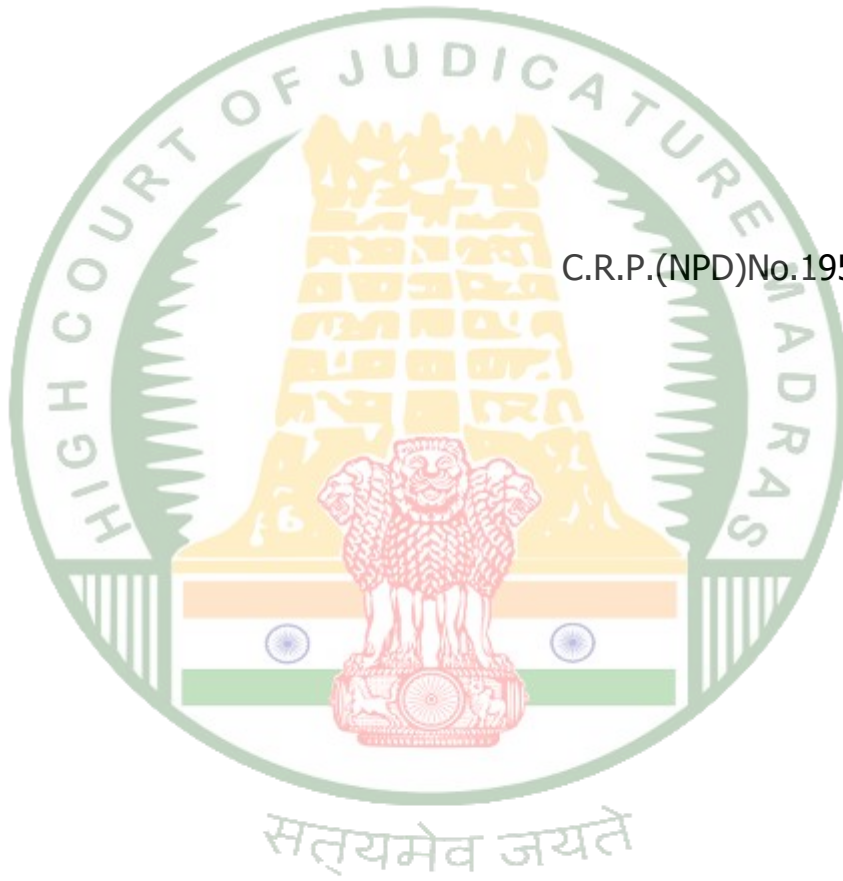
