J U D G M E N T

(Judgment of the Court was made by Dr.Vineet Kothari, J.)

The learned counsel for the respondents 2 & 4 Mr.O.R.Santhanakrishnan, submits that the present appeal has become infructuous as the Distributorship of the Gas Agency of the Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) has been made in favour of the fifth respondent long ago and thereafter, fresh allotment was also made in favour of the sixth respondent M/s.Gokulam Agency, whereas, the present appellant Ms.Seeniammal sought allotment of such Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) distributorship, in view of the advertisement published wayback on 24.09.1984.

2. In view of the submissions made, we are of the considered opinion that nothing survives for further adjudication in the Writ Appeal and the same has become infructuous. Accordingly, the Writ Appeal is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

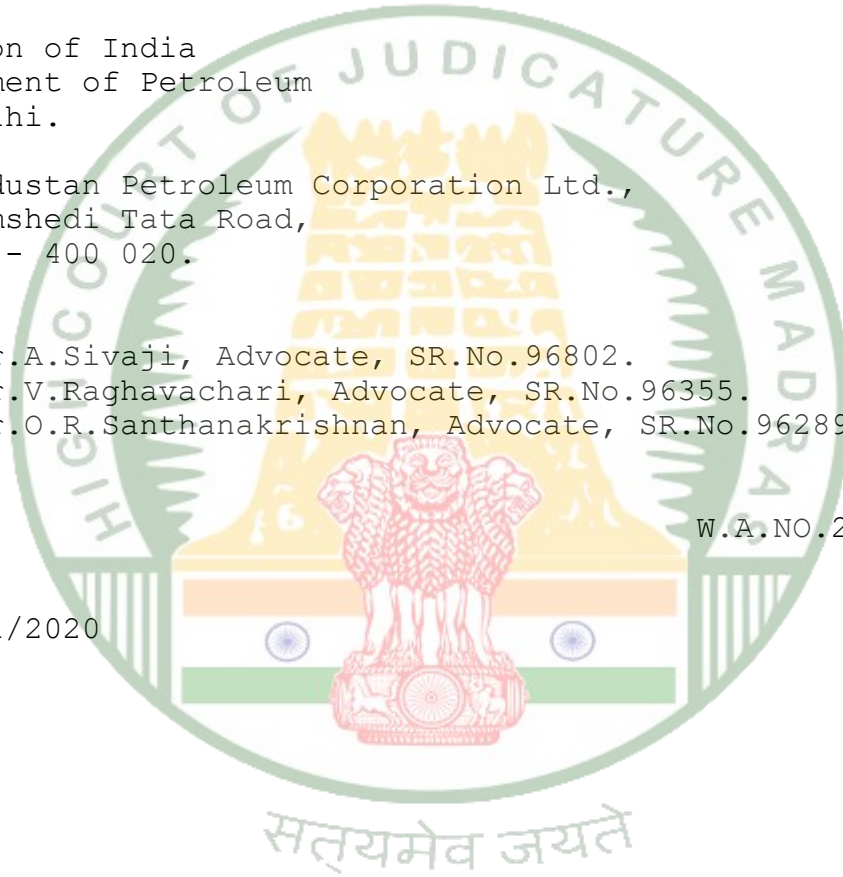
