TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.2,73,920/- with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till the date of deposit as compensation, for the injury sustained by the respondent herein.

2. Transport Corporation filed an appeal aggrieved by the award. It is represented by the learned counsel for the appellant that the entire award amount has already been deposited and therefore, the award passed by the Tribunal may be confirmed. Accordingly, the award of the tribunal stands confirmed. The appeal stands dismissed.

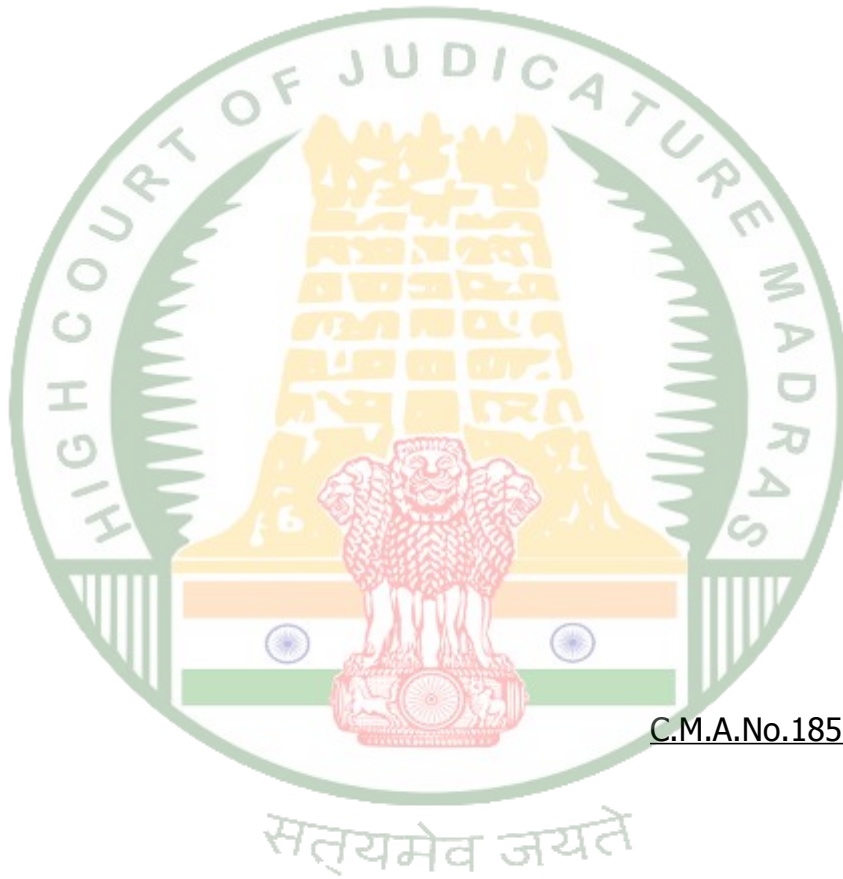
