

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the view that if the vehicle is returned, the same may be sold by the petitioner/accused

and it will certainly hamper the progress of the trial. In the said circumstances, the learned Judicial Magistrate dismissed the petition. Therefore this Court finds that the order passed by the learned Magistrate is well founded and does not suffer from any infirmity. Hence, the present Criminal Revision Case is dismissed.
