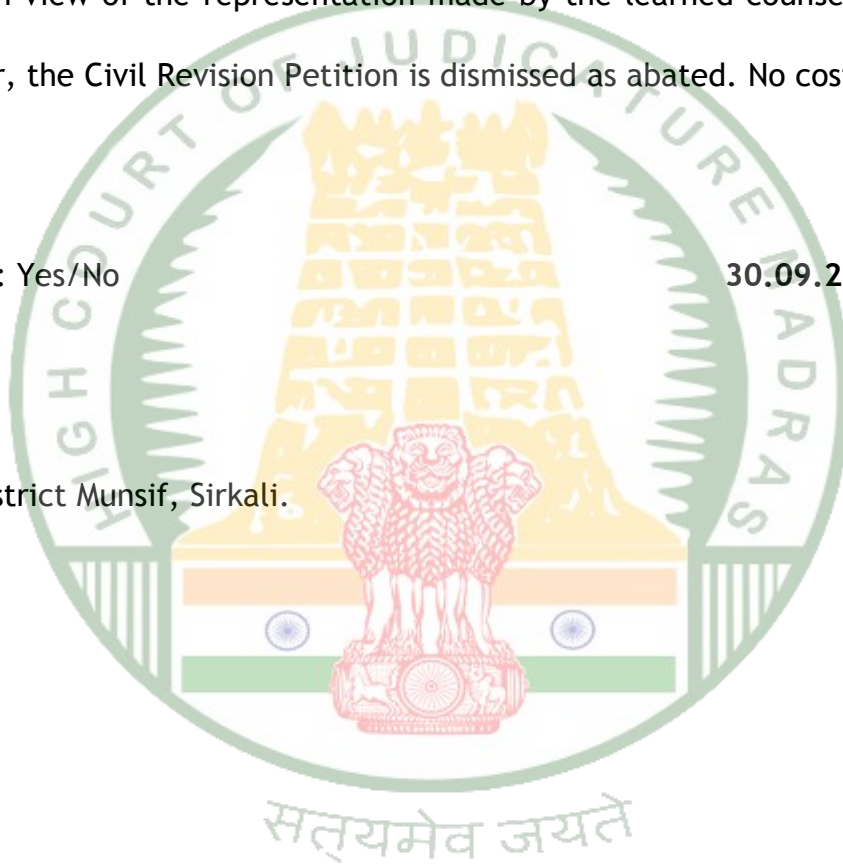
2.In view of the representation made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the Civil Revision Petition is dismissed as abated. No costs.
