Though this case was not listed in the Cause List, on mentioning, this case is taken up for settlement before this Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. Mr.K.J.Sivakumar, learned counsel for appellant is present and respondent appeared party-in-person. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till the date of deposit. Aggrieved by the said compensation, the appellant/ Transport Corporation has preferred the present appeal.

2. After due deliberation and consultation, both the parties agreed to modify the award of the Tribunal to a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs and Fifty thousand only) in full quit.

3. It is represented by the Appellant-Transport Corporation that they have already deposited a sum of Rs.2,66,000/-. The appellant Transport Corporation is permitted to withdraw the balance amount. The share of the minor claimant shall be deposited in any one of the Nationalized Bank, till she attains the age of majority and the guardian of the minor claimant namely, Mr.Ramadurai is entitled to withdraw the accrued interest, once in three months.

4. The Tribunal is directed to transfer the above said award amount to the Bank account of the respondent / claimant by way of NEFT / RTGS, on proper identification, in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition.

5. The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of accordingly.
Consequently, connected civil miscellaneous petition, if any, is closed.

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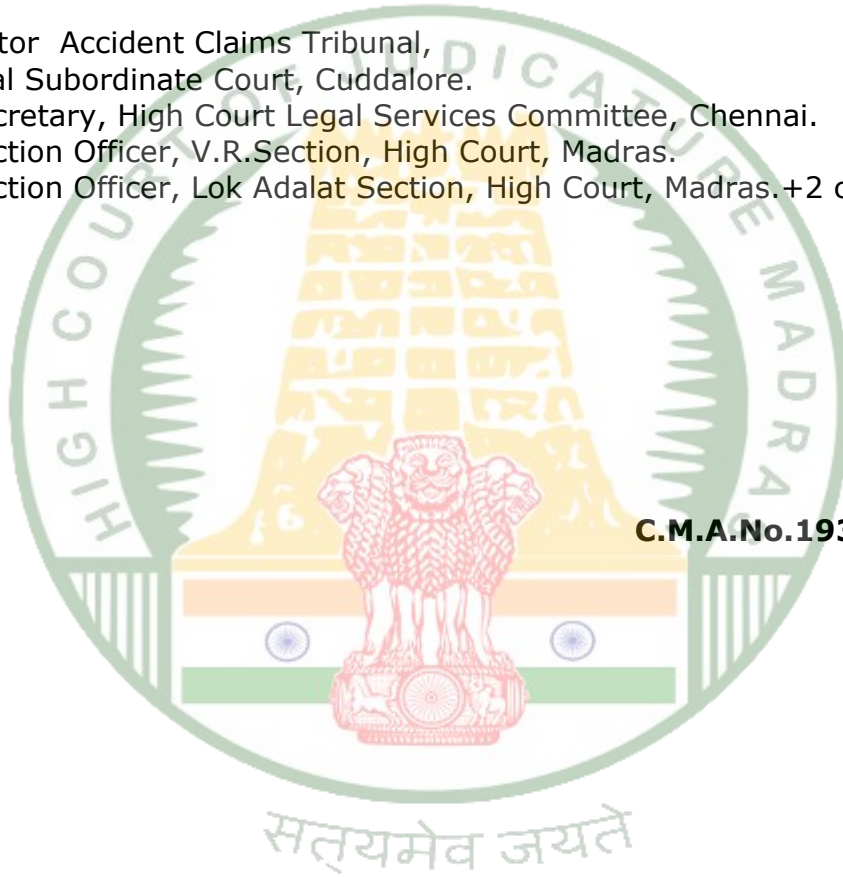
