2. It is seen that when the matter was posted on 01.04.2016 "For Admission", the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner took an adjournment and the matter was adjourned to 07.06.2016. Thereafter, for the past three years, the learned counsel has not taken any steps to list the matter. It shows

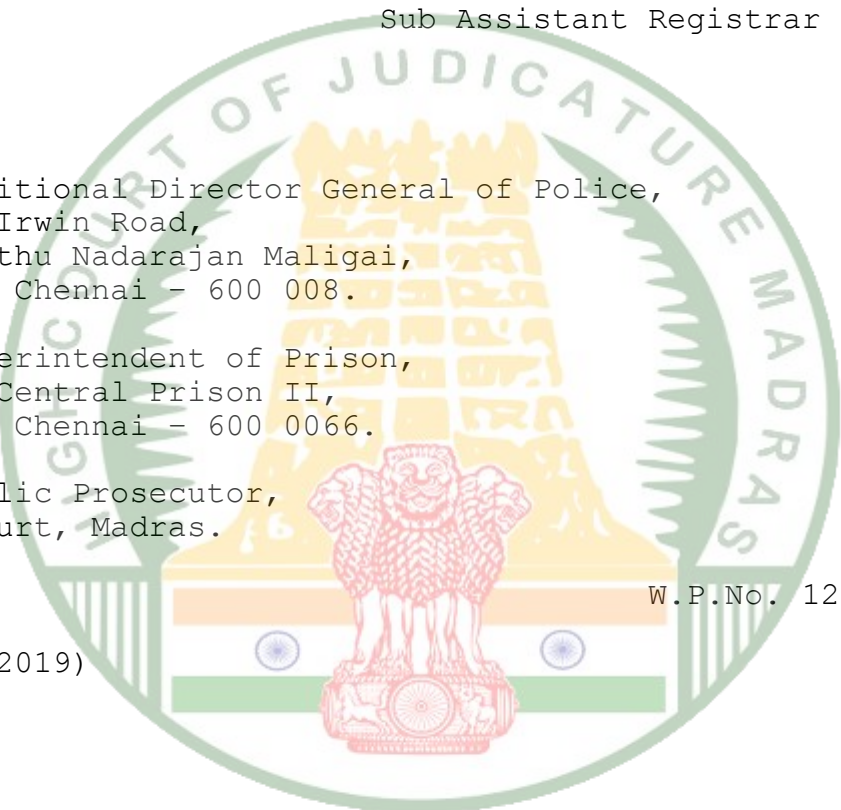
