Prayer : Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records of the 2nd respondent relating to the impugned proceedings in Order No.Va.Va.P.6/38340/2010 culminating in his order dated 08.05.2012 following the rejection of appeal by the 1st respondent vide his Letter No.26778/Ne.A4(1)/2010-10 dated 23.04.2012 and relating to the impugned proceedings in Order No.Va.Va.P.2/38340/2010 in his order dated 23.09.2010 and quash the same and consequently direct the 2nd respondent to permit the petitioner to reside in the premises at No.62, Model Hutment Road, C.I.T.
