2. Learned counsel reiterates the aforesaid endorsement.

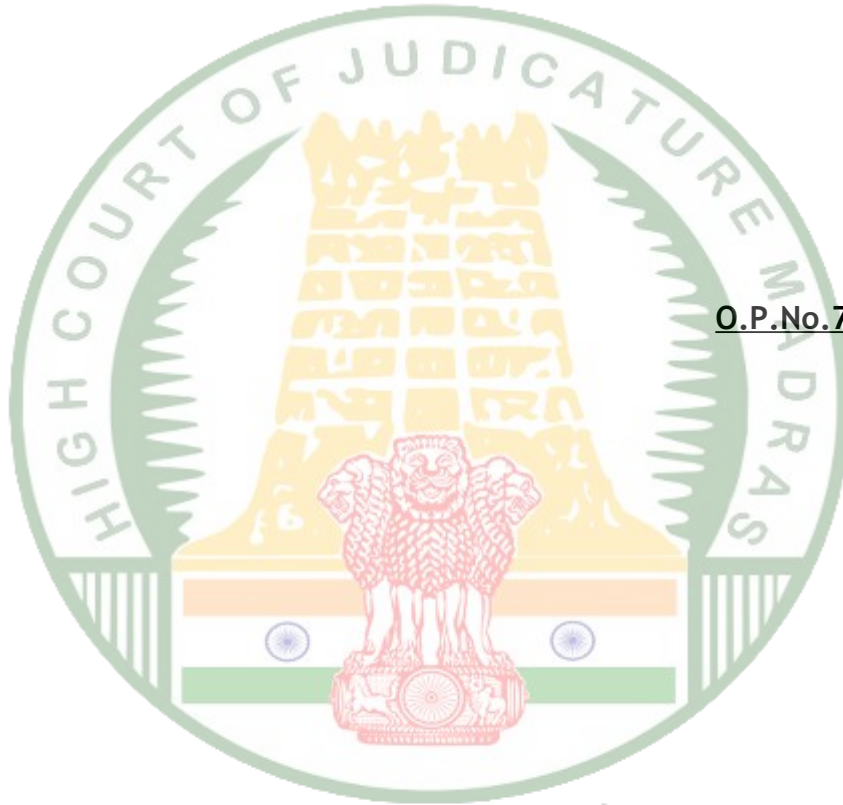
