After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.5,46,200/-with interest at 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till the date of deposit with proportionate costs as compensation.

2. Aggrieved against the award of the Tribunal, the appellant/Transport Corporation has preferred this appeal.

3. The appellant stated that they are not pursuing the appeal. It is further represented by the appellant/Transport Corporation that they have deposited the entire award amount with interest in the Tribunal.

4. In view of the same, the award of the Tribunal is confirmed.
