2.It is seen from the records that almost four years have been lapsed and hence, due to the lapse of period, the prayer sought for by the petitioner cannot be granted now.

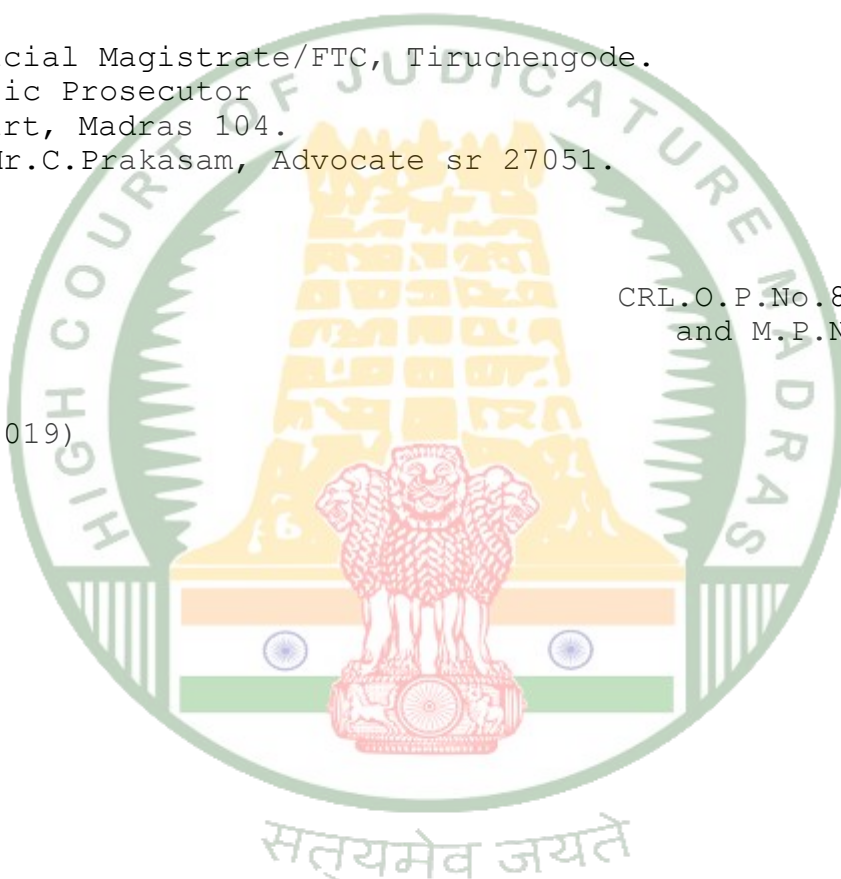
3.With the above observation, the Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed as devoid of merits. However, the trial Court is directed to complete the trial within a period of three
