Commissioner, Greater Chennai Corporation, stated that the said
premises have been locked and sealed on 22.7.2019.

4. The learned counsel for the second respondent as well as
the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the third
respondent, i.e., the Joint Commissioner, Chennai Region, Hindu
Religious and Charitable Endowments Department, stated that in
relation to the unauthorized construction, they will take
further steps in accordance with law.

5. In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for respondents 2 and 3, no further orders are necessary at this stage. Accordingly, the writ petition is closed. No costs.
