2. It is seen that the writ petitioner was appointed on a consolidated basis for implementing the Total Sanitation Programme in Pappireddipatti Block in Dharmapuri District. Admittedly, it was a scheme appointment. The learned Government Advocate now submits that the scheme in respect of which the writ petitioner was appointed itself has been wound up.
