There shall be an order of interim stay on condition that the petitioner/insurance company deposits 50% of the compensation amount awarded by the Tribunal along with proportionate interest to the credit of M.C.O.P.No.740 of 2016 on the file of the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal (Additional Sub Court), Puducherry, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

3. On such deposit, the first respondent/claimant is permitted to withdraw 50% of the amount deposited along accrued interest. This Civil Miscellaneous Petition is disposed of accordingly.
