The suit itself one for declaration and recovery of possession of the "B" schedule property. Pending appeal, an injunction is sought for restraining the respondents from interfering with the alleged possession of the plaintiffs. The suit being one for declaration of title and recovery of possession, I do not see any reason to grant an order of injunction. Hence, the C.M.P.No. 4545 of 2019 is dismissed.

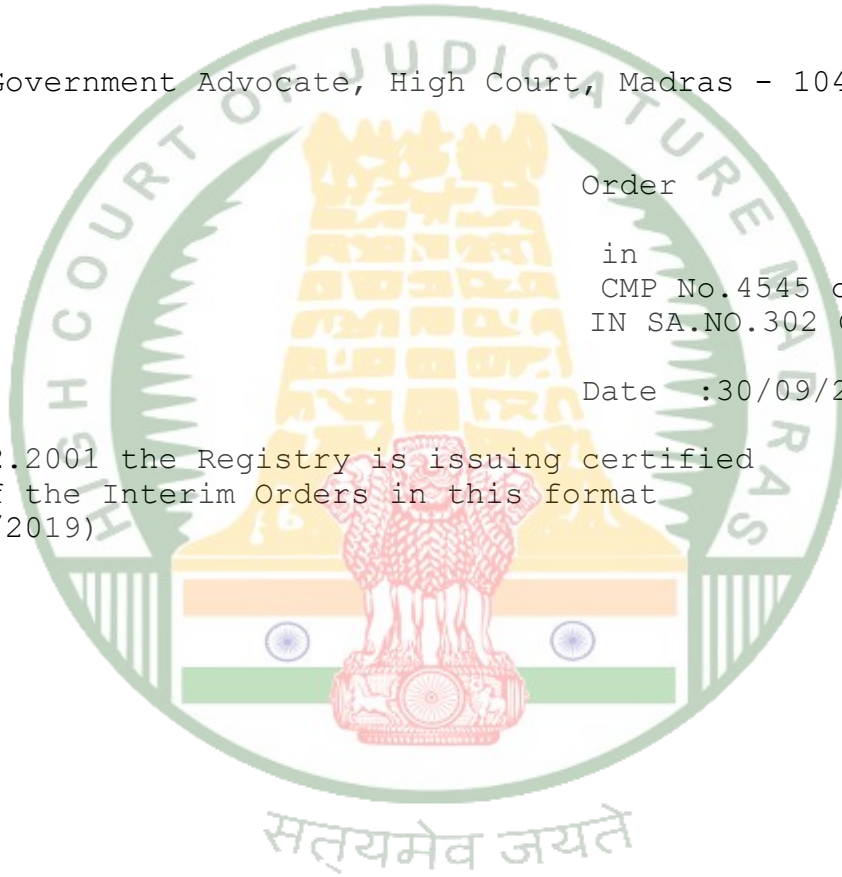
