The relief sought for in the present Writ Petition is to forbear the changing of service condition in view of the pendency of I.D.No.687 of 2000 before the learned Presiding Officer, Labour Court, Salem.

2. Today, when the matter is called, it is brought to the notice of this Court that I.D.No.687 of 2000 is still pending before the Labour Court, Salem. In my view, if the proceedings pending before the Labour Court is directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time, the ends of justice would be met.

3. In the light of the above observations, the Writ Petition stands disposed of with a direction to the learned Presiding Officer, Labour Court, to dispose of the proceedings in I.D.No.687 of 2000, within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
