3.In view of the above, the order made in Crl.M.P.No.10311 of 2018 in Crl.A.No.459 of 2018 dated 21.08.2018 is modified to the effect that the 1st petitioner shall appear before the Trial Court once in two months at 10.30 a.m. and as far as the 2nd petitioner is concerned the condition imposed on him is hereby fully relaxed as he hails from North East. However, the 2nd petitioner will make himself available, as and when required by the respondent instead of appearing before the Trial Court on the first working day of every English Calendar month at 10.30 a.m.
