

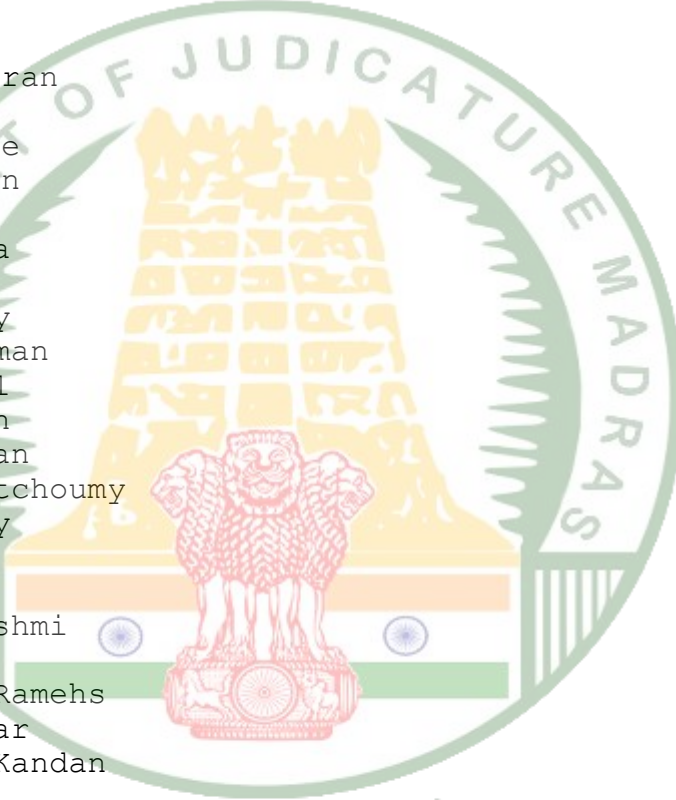

ORDER

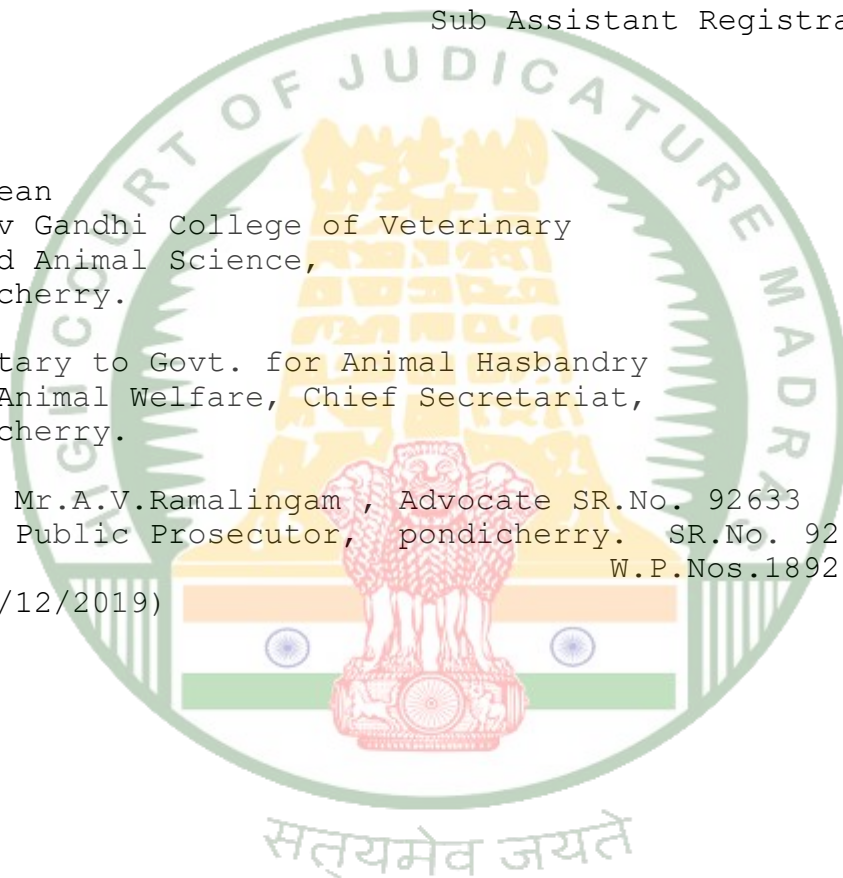
