2.Recording the said submission, the writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is also closed.

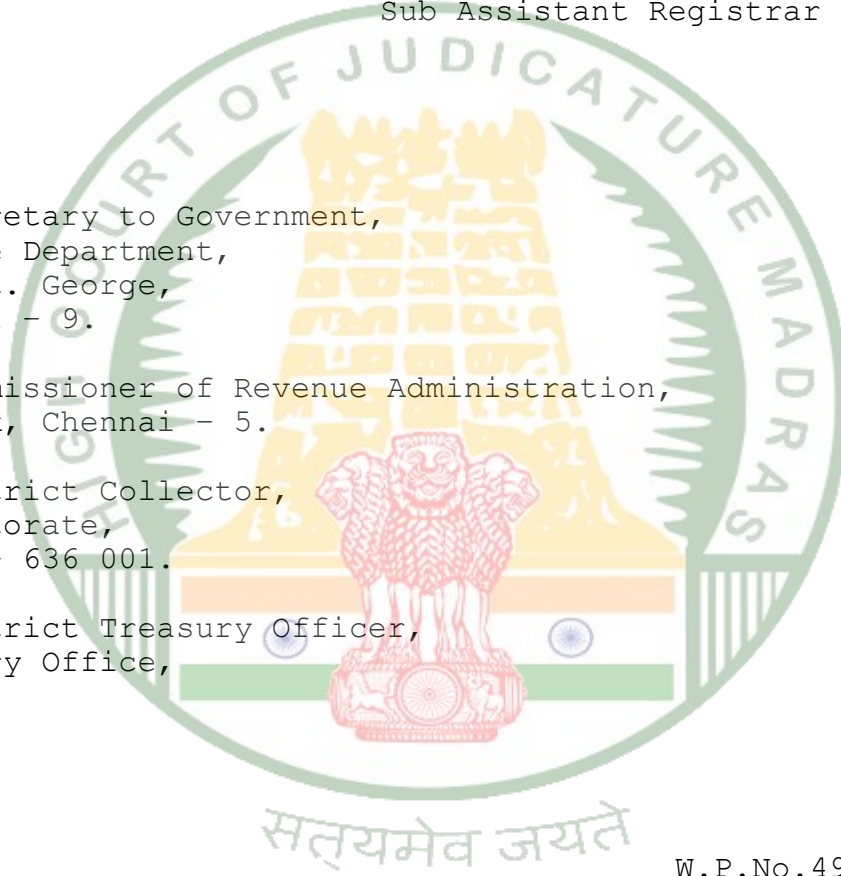
