Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking for a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records of the impugned notice issued under Section 6 of the Tamil Nadu Land Encroachment Act 1905 on 12.09.2004 by the Tahsildar, Tindivanam the 3rd respondent herein quash the same and direct the respondents 2, 3 and 5 i.e., the District Collector, Villupuram, the Tahsildar, Tindivanam, the Revenue Inspector, Marakkanam, or their subordinates not to take any coercive steps to evict the petitioner from the land under his occupation in Survey No.1 to an extent of 1.09.0 acres at 215 Anumanthai Village, Tindivanam Taluk, Villupuram District and

grant lease in favour of the petitioner in respect of the aforesaid land on the basis of the petitioner's application submitted to the 2nd respondent on 06.08.2003.
