Prayer: This Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, praying to grant a general direction directing the 2nd respondent to file a report pertaining to the detention of the detainee by name S.Nandhini and in pursuance direct the learned Judicial Magistrate-I, Alandur to dispose of Crl.M.P.No. Not known of 2019 in Crime No.2 of 2019 as expeditiously.

ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed by the husband of the 4th respondent.

2. It is the case of the petitioner that his wife came to Chennai for employment and worked in Beauty Parlour at Chennai. On 22.01.2019, the first respondent Police have registered a case against the owner of parlour in Crime No.2 of 2019, for an offence under Sections 3(2) (a), 4(1) and 5(1)a of Immoral

Traffic Prevention Act. The 4th respondent has been branded as victim and has been kept in a home run by the 3rd respondent for more than one month. In spite of best efforts, made by the petitioner, 4th respondent is not being released from the home on the ground that the P.O. Report has not been submitted before the Court till date. It is also seen that the accused person in the above case has already been enlarged on bail.

3. This Court under similar circumstances had directed the release of the detainees from the home by an order dated 20.11.2018 made in CrI.O.P.Nos.27063 and 27064 of 2018.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to direct the 3rd respondent to immediately release the 4th respondent from Government Home for Woman, Mylapore. The petitioner before taking the 4th respondent from Home, shall produce the necessary evidence to show her relationship with the 4th respondent. The 4th respondent on being released from the Home, shall stay at Chennai and report before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 9 Alandur, once in a week on Monday at 10.30.a.m till the P.O. Report is submitted before this Court.

5. This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above directions and consequently the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
