3. In any event, there is no representation for the revision petitioner. Hence all the revisions petitions are dismissed. No costs. The connected civil miscellaneous petitions are closed.

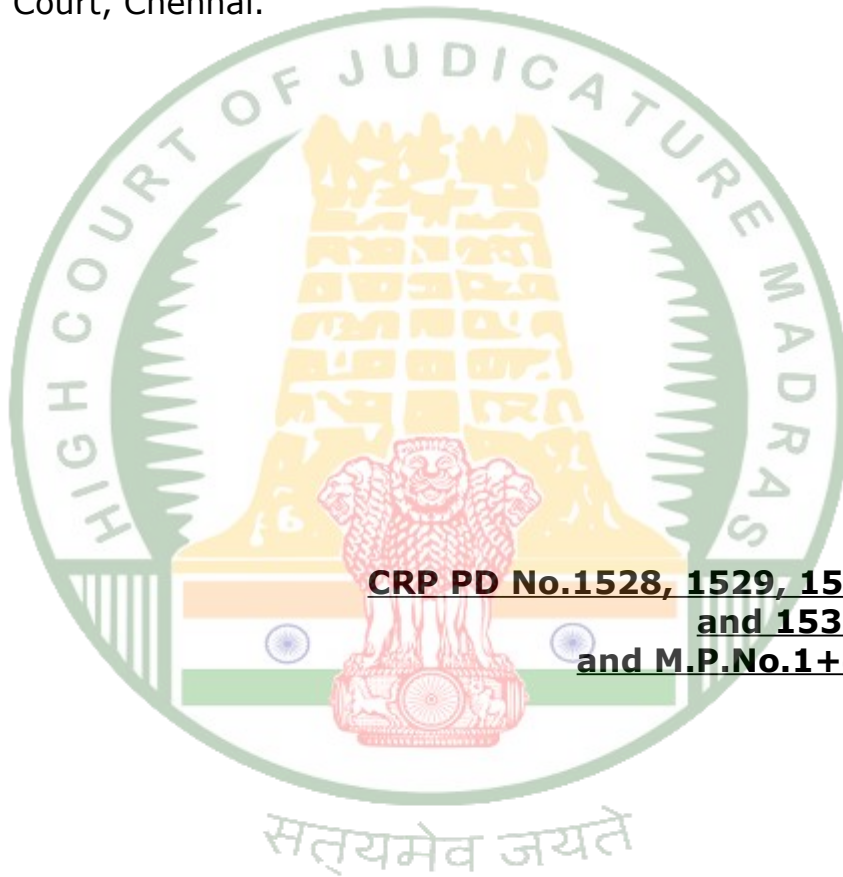
