ORDER

This Court passed an order on 30.09.2011 as follows;

"The above matter is listed today i.e., on 30.09.2011, under the caption 'Default cases'; for non compliance of the requirements of the Registry, including the payment of batta.

2. When the matter is listed today before this Court today i.e., 01.10.2019, on verification, the directions issued by this Court on 30.09.2011 has not been complied with. The above Order states that in the event of non-compliance, the writ petition shall stand dismissed automatically.

3. In view of the said Order, no further consideration is required in respect of the grounds raised in the present writ petition and accordingly the writ petition stands dismissed. No costs.
