Hence, the Registry was directed to list the matter on 25.09.2019 (i.e.) today under the caption "for dismissal". Today also, though the name of the petitioner has been printed in the cause list, none appeared for the petitioner. Hence, this Court has no other option, except to dismiss the Civil Revision Petition for non-prosecution. Accordingly, the Civil Revision Petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. No costs.
