2.In view of the same, the civil revision petitions are dismissed as infructuous. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed. No costs.

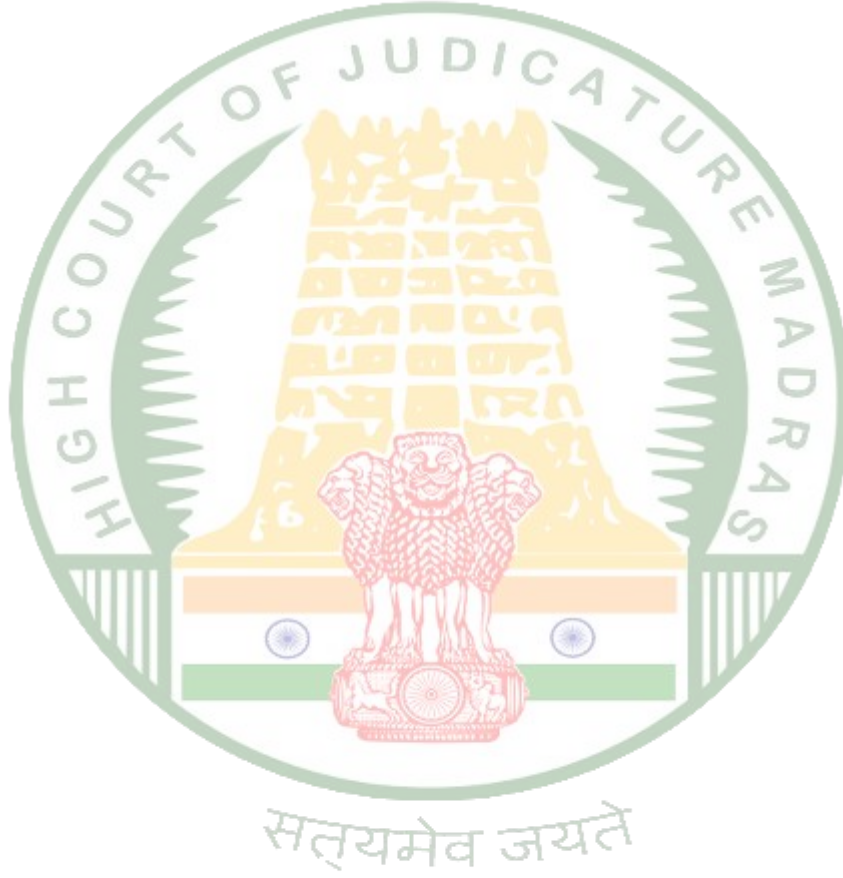
