Prayer: Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code, to direct the respondent to grant permission and provide police protection to the petitioner's village to conduct the cultural program on the eve of the temple festival of the Sri Vinayagar Maa Vilakku Thiruvizha, Baleguli Village, Mariamman Thidal, Krishnagiri Taluk & District which is scheduled to be held on 07.02.2019 based on the representation of the petitioner dated 01.02.2019.

O R D E R

Seeking permission to conduct cultural programme in the event of Sri Vinayagar Maa Vilakku Thiruvizha at Baleguli Village, Mariamman Thidal, Krishnagiri Taluk & District, the petitioner made a representation dated 01.02.2019 to the respondent. As the same has not been considered, the present Criminal Original petition has been filed.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

3. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, would submit that there is likelihood of arising law and order problem.

4. A mere apprehension cannot be a ground to reject the representation. There is absolutely no material before this Court to hold that there will be a law and order problem in the event of permission being granted. In such view of the matter, the petitioner is permitted to conduct cultural programme in the event of Baleguli Village, Mariamman Thidal, Sri Vinayagar Maa Vilakku Thiruvizha, Krishnagiri Taluk & District, however with the following conditions:-

(a) The cultural programme in connection with the event of Sri Vinayagar Maa Vilakku Thiruvizha, at Baleguli Village, Mariamman Thidal, Krishnagiri Taluk & District, shall be conducted on 07.02.2019 between 06.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m.

(b) There should not be any kind of obscene dance or vulgar dialogues during the performance, by anyone of the participants.

(c) Double meaning songs should not be played so as to spoil the minds of students and youths.

(d) No dance or songs, touching upon any political party or religion or community or caste shall be played.

(e) No flex boards in support of any political party or communal leader, shall be erected at the premises of the programme.

(f) The function shall not affect either religious or communal harmony and shall be conducted without any discrimination based on caste.

(g) If there is violation of any one of the conditions imposed, the concerned police officer is at liberty to take necessary action, as per law and stop such performance forthwith; and

(h) Similarly, the police is directed to stop the dance programme, if it is played beyond the permitted time limit.

(i) The respondent is directed to issue necessary permission, incorporating the above conditions.

5. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
