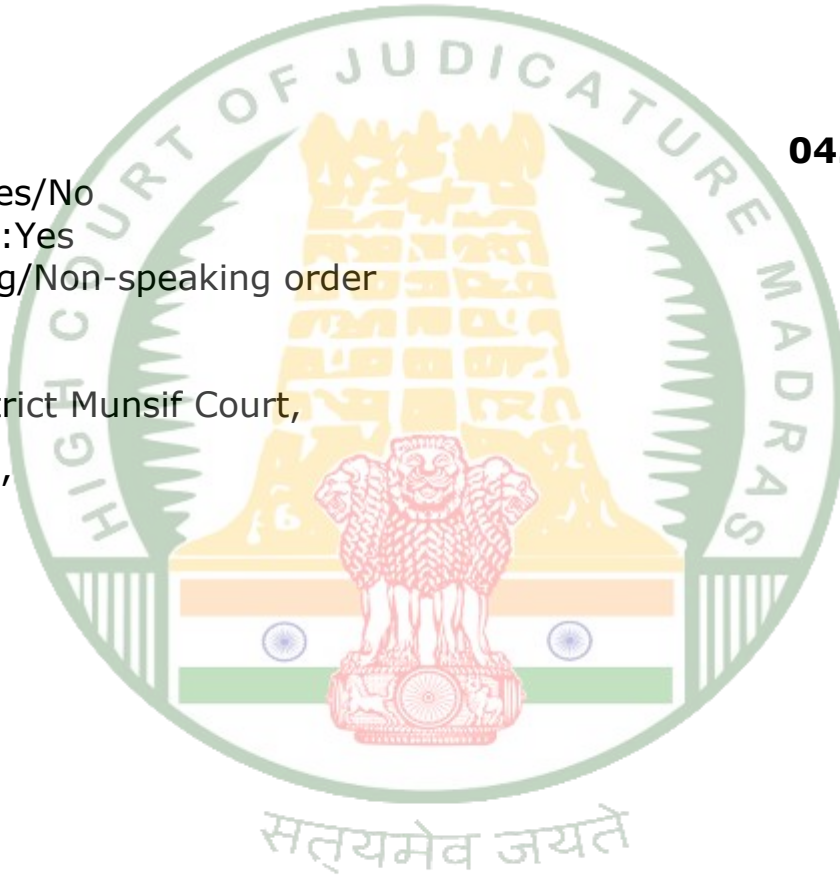
ORDER

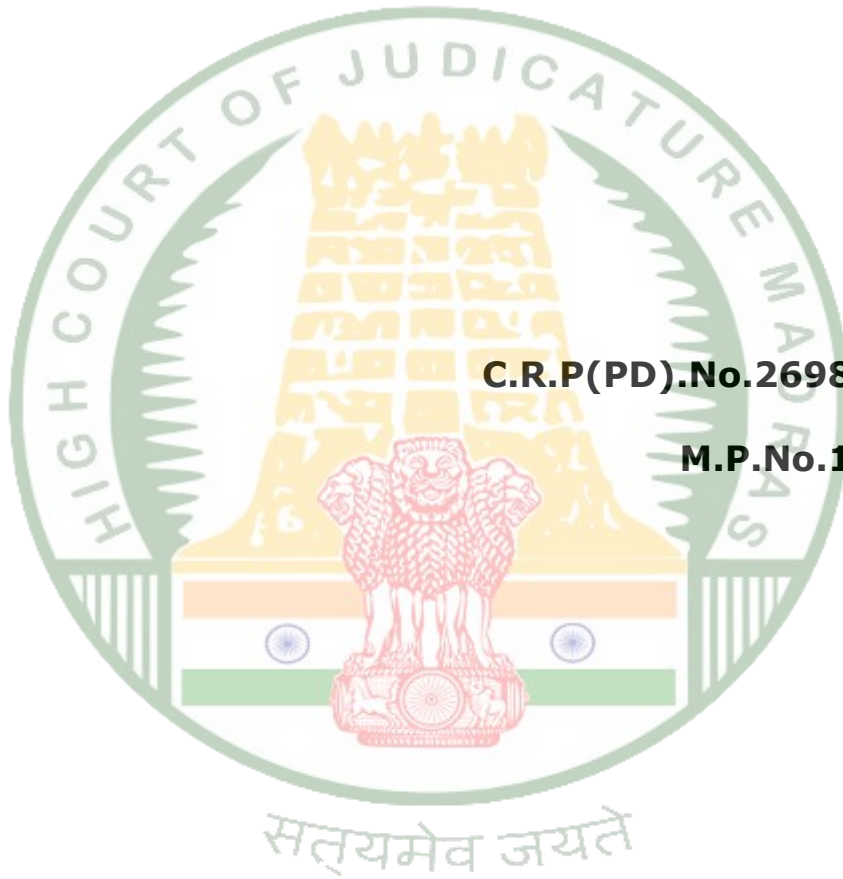
