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O R D E R

This Writ Petition is filed seeking for a Mandamus, directing the the 1st respondent to pass appropriate orders on the application filed by the petitioner under Section 23(1) of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.

Therefore, this Writ Petition is disposed of, only with a direction to the 1st respondent to consider the application filed by the petitioner and pass orders on the same on merits and in accordance with law, after hearing the petitioner, respondents 2 to 5 and other interested parties, if any. Such exercise shall be done by the 1st respondent within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
