Mr.J.Purushothaman, learned Government Advocate takes notice for the respondents. By consent of the parties, this main writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

The petitioner seeks for a Mandamus directing the respondents to consider and grant permission on the petitioner's representation dated 13.02.2019 seeking to perform Devotional Music Concert on 18.02.2019 at Andampallam Village, Kilpennathur Taluk, Tiruvannamalai District on account of Mandala Poojai Temple Festival of Sri Muthu Mari Amman Temple, at Andampallam Village, Kilpennathur Taluk, Tiruvannamalai.

Recording the above said submission, this Writ Petition is disposed of, by directing the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 13.02.2019 and pass orders on the same on merits and in accordance with law by today itself, since it is stated that the event has to take place today i.e. on 18.02.2019.
