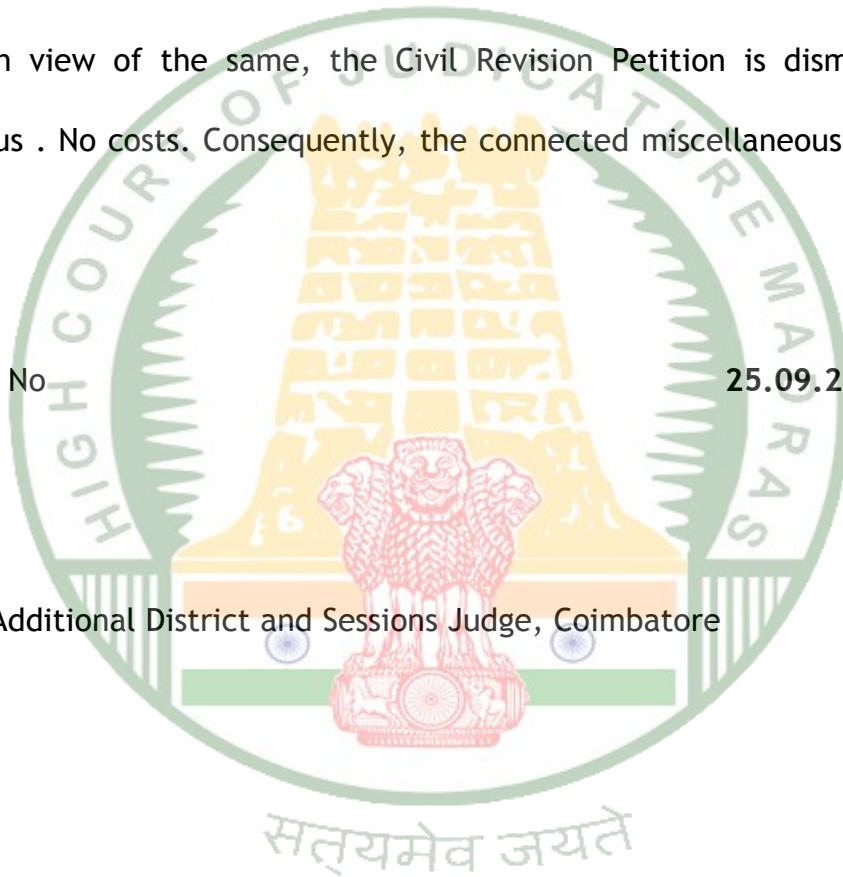
2.In view of the same, the Civil Revision Petition is dismissed as infructuous . No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
