ORDER

No representation for the petitioners.

2. This contempt petition has been filed for the second time to punish the respondents for wilful disobedience of the order dated 20.7.2015 passed in Contempt Petition No.1156 of 2014. When the earlier contempt petition filed by the petitioners was closed, while dismissing the review application filed by the first respondent herein, recording the communication dated 11.7.2010 sent by the Tahsildar, Velacherry that the road abutting the petitioners' plot is not encroached and kept open with compound wall and gate on the eastern side with easy access to the petitioners' vacant plot, therefore, the Corporation of Chennai can form the road and declare it as public road as per the lay out given by the Tamil Nadu Housing Board coupled with the fact that since the gift deed has already been given by the Tamil Nadu Housing Board to the Corporation of Chennai, they cannot have any grievance, but to accept the gift deed and do the needful for granting approval to the writ petitioners, as there is no encroachment in the land gifted, this contempt petition stands closed, as the interest of the petitioners has been

safeguarded. Consequently, Sub Application No.692 of 2016 is also closed.

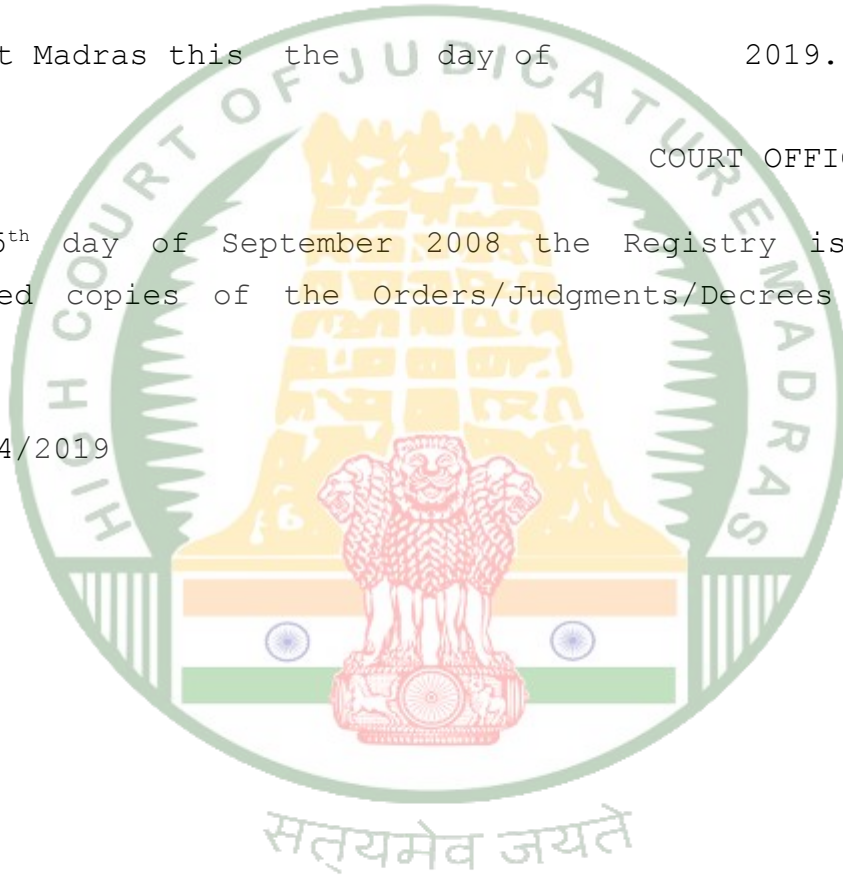
