Taking into consideration that the work entrusted to the learned Advocate Commissioner has been complied with and by appreciating the efforts taken by him, this Court feels that a sum of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) shall be paid to the learned Advocate Commissioner as Additional remuneration apart from the initial remuneration paid to him within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
