Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and Memorandum of Grounds in Crl.OP.NO.5885 OF 2019 On the file of the High Court and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.P.K.GANESH, Advocate for the petitioner, the court made the following order:-

Notice of motion returnable by 09.04.2019. Private Notice is also permitted.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to inform the learned counsel who appears for the respondent in the trial Court, about the pendency of this quash petition, so that she can make arrangements to enter appearance before this Court.

3.The petitioners/respondents 2 to 4 are the in-laws of the respondent. Therefore, the presence of the petitioners are dispensed with pending disposal of Criminal Original Petition, on condition that, they shall ensure that the first petitioner's son/husband of the respondent shall deposit a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) before 5th of every English Calendar month to the credit of D.V.C.No.2 of 2019 on the file of the XV Metropolitan Magistrate, George Town, Chennai as *ad-interim* maintenance, without prejudice to both the parties. On such deposit being made, the respondent is entitled to withdraw the same. For the month of March, 2019, the said sum of Rs.5,000/- shall be deposited on or before 09.03.2019. The learned XV Metropolitan Magistrate, George Town is

directed to proceed with the trial in D.V.C.No.2 of 2019 in respect of the petitioner's son/first respondent alone.
