2. The petitioner seeks for a mandamus directing the respondent herein to dispose of the revision petition dated 12.03.2018 filed against the order dated 27.06.2017 passed by the Sub-Collector, Hosur, arising out of patta proceedings.

4. The grievance of the petitioner before this Court is that the said revision petition has not been disposed of by the respondent so far.

5. This Court, at this stage, is not expressing any view on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner, as it is for the
