

Application No.1795 of 2019**PUSHPA SATHYANARAYANA, J.**

This Court, upon hearing the learned counsel for the applicant, vide order dated 08.03.2019, directed the respondents to furnish security to the extent of the claim made in the application being an amount of Rs.4,61,865/-, on or before 05.04.2019, failing which, an order of attachment order would be passed.

2. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, learned counsel for the applicant would submit that no security has been furnished as directed by this Court. He would further submit that an award in arbitration between the applicant and the respondents has been passed on 26.10.2017.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the applicant.

4. Notices sent to respondents with regard to furnish security ordered by this Court have been served and affidavit of service is also filed to that effect enclosing acknowledgement cards. Though the names of the respondents are also printed in the cause list, there is no representation for them either in person or through counsel. Hence, service to the respondents is held sufficient.

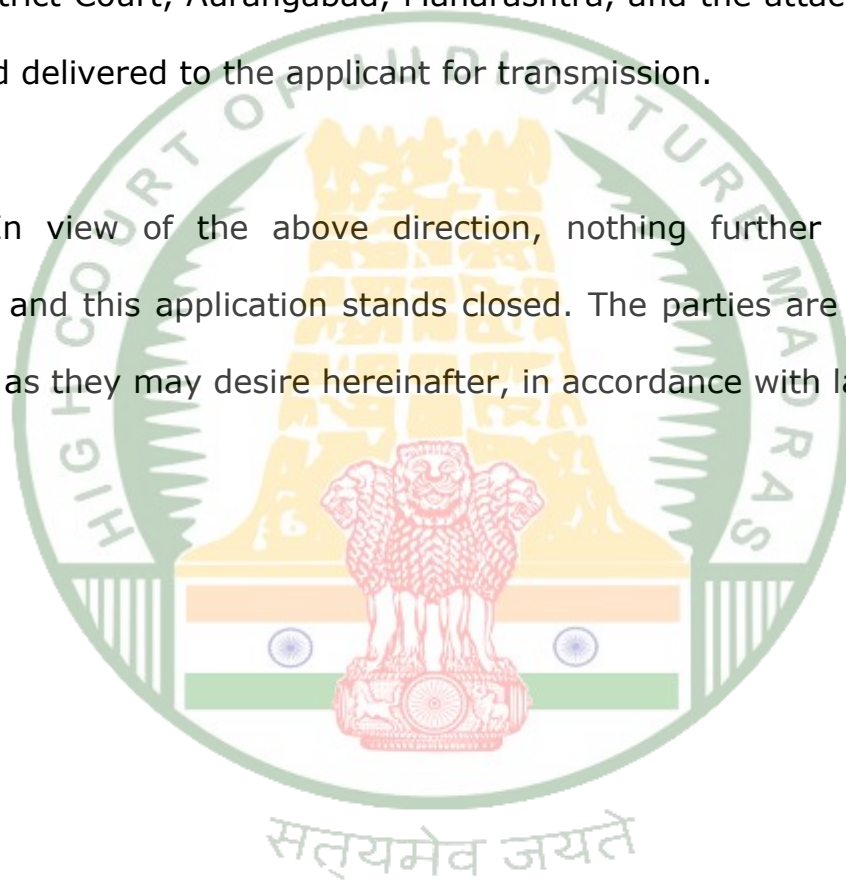
