ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed by
the petitioner to quash the proceedings in F.I.R in Crime
No.131 of 2019 on the file of the Inspector of Police, J-
6, Thiruvannamiyur Police Station, Chennai.

2.The case is still in the trial stage. By passage
of time, the parties have decided to bury their hatchet
and compromise the dispute amicably among themselves.

3.A Joint Memo of Compromise dated 05.03.2019 has
been filed before this Court, which have been signed by
the petitioners and the second respondent. All the
parties are present and identified by their respective
counsel and the Police. This Court also enquired both the
parties and was satisfied that the parties have come to
an amicable settlement between themselves.

4. Under such circumstances, no useful purpose will be served in keeping the case in Crime No.131 of 2019 pending, even though, the offences involved are not compoundable in nature. In the light of the guidelines given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reported in 2017 9 SCC 641-(Parbathbhai Aahir @ Parbathbhai Vs. State of Gujrath), this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. quashes the proceedings in Crime No.131 of 2019.

5. This Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and as a sequel, the proceedings in Crime No.131 of 2019, on the file of the Inspector of Police, J-6, Thiruvanmiyur Police Station, Chennai, is quashed and the terms of Joint Memo of Compromise dated 05.03.2019 shall form part and parcel of this Order. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
