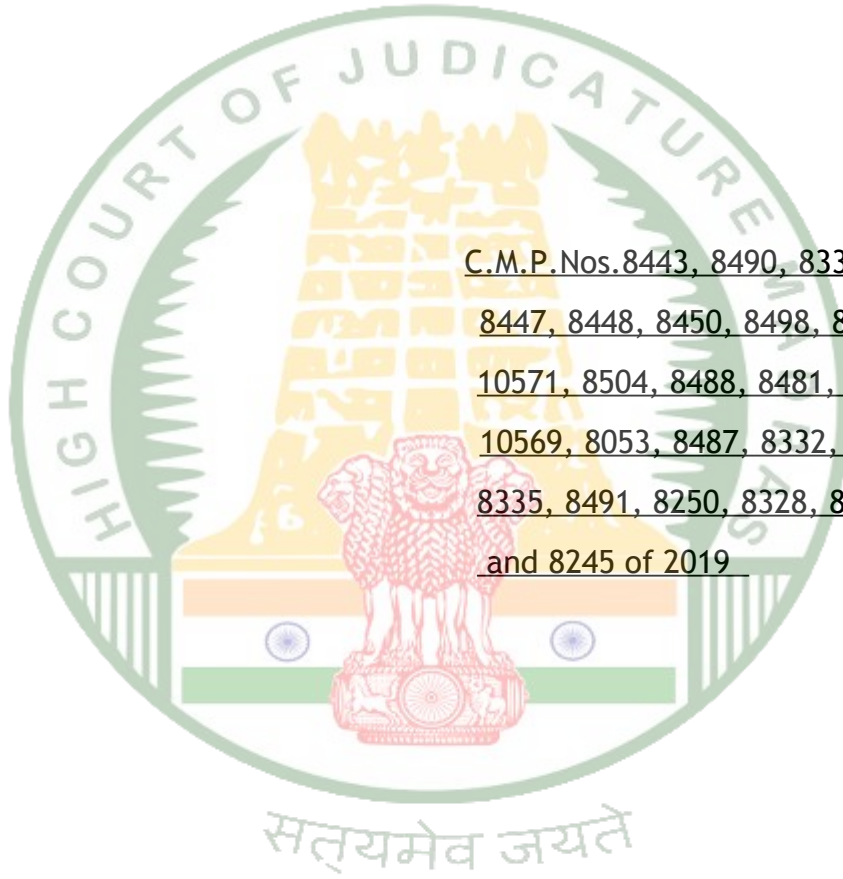
4. The Registry is directed to restore the above civil revision petitions if they are in order.
