C O M M O N O R D E R

The grievances of the writ petitioners are that the differential amount of DCRG and the consequential benefits are yet to be paid by the respondents.

2.In this regard, the writ petitioners submitted representation to the respondents on 27.02.2019, 17.12.2018, 04.01.2019, 02.03.2019, 04.03.2019, 06.03.2019, 09.03.2019. The earlier representations submitted by the writ petitioners were also not considered.

3.Thus, without going into the merits of the matter, the 2nd respondent is directed to consider the representations submitted by the writ petitioners on 27.02.2019, 17.12.2018, 04.01.2019, 02.03.2019, 04.03.2019, 06.03.2019, 09.03.2019 and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of 12 weeks from the

date of receipt of a copy of this order. The writ petitioners are also directed to enclose the copies of the representation and all relevant Government orders along with the orders passed in the writ petitions.

4. Accordingly, both the writ petitions stand disposed of. However, there shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
