ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by M.M.SUNDRESH, J.)

Seeking a direction to the respondent to produce the body of the detainee namely Mrs.S. Usharani, aged about 37 years and set her at liberty, the present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the petitioner/husband of the detenu.

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that it is the second time the detainee has left with the third respondent .

3. Thus, we do not find any illegal detention involved in this case. However, we direct the respondents 1 and 2 to proceed with the investigation. As and when, the detainee is secured, she should be produced before the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate.

4. In view of the above, the Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.
