When the matter is taken up today, Mr.A.Saravanan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner in the above miscellaneous petitions would submit that the petitioner was unable to find proper sureties for him and thereby, the petitioner was not able to comply with the order dated 25.04.2019, granting suspension of sentences to him and hence, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the above petitions with a liberty to move fresh applications.

3 In view of the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the **order dated 25.04.2019** granting suspension of sentence to the petitioner in the above miscellaneous petitions stands **cancelled** and the petitions are **dismissed as withdrawn for the present**.
