also to be included along with basic wages for the purpose of
calculating contribution.

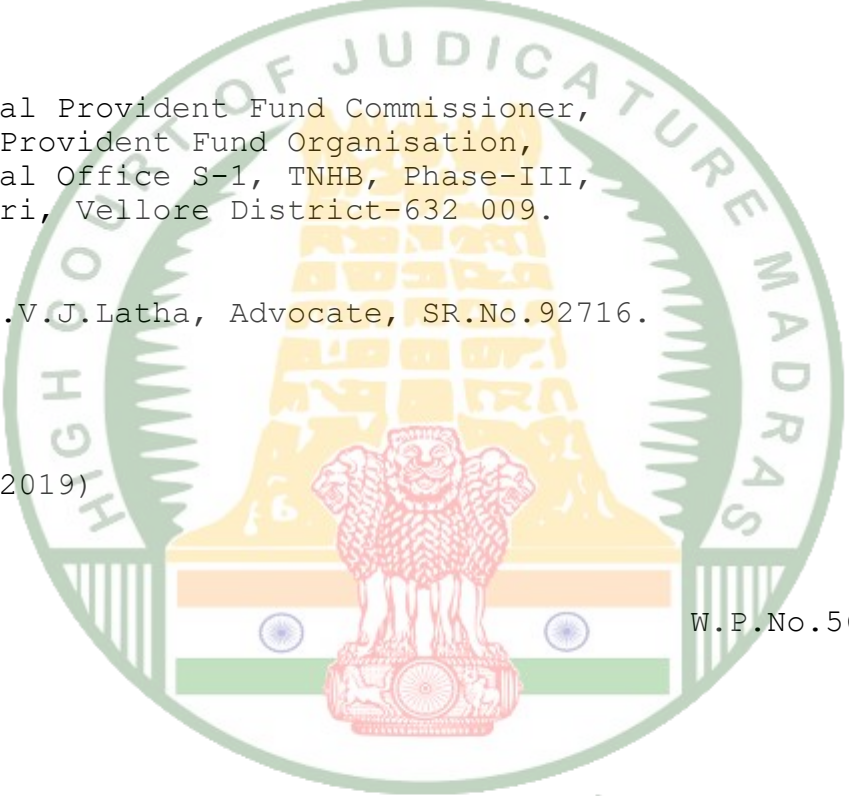
