2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that FIR in Crime No.139 of 2019 pending on the file of the 1st respondent police has been enquired and the same was closed on 16.04.2019 as 'Mistake of Fact' and the closure report has also been filed before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvotriyur.

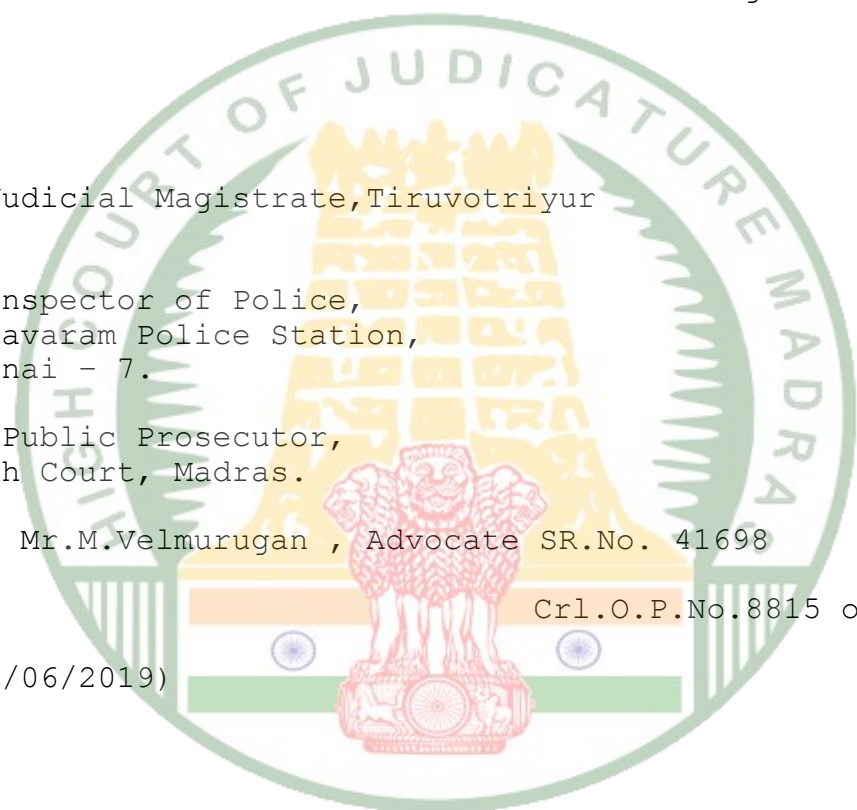
