COMMON ORDER

3. The writ petitioners are directed to enclose the copy of the appeal along with all other relevant documents passed in this regard. Accordingly, the writ petitions stand disposed of. However, there shall be no order as to costs.

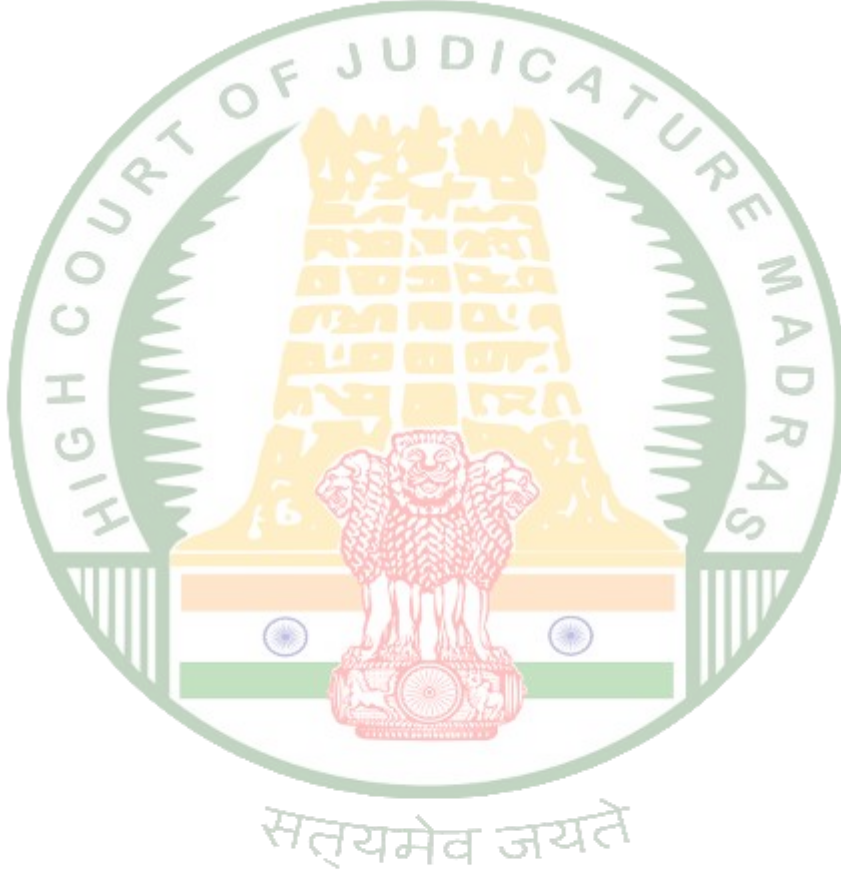
