3.The learned Judge is directed to dispose of the same

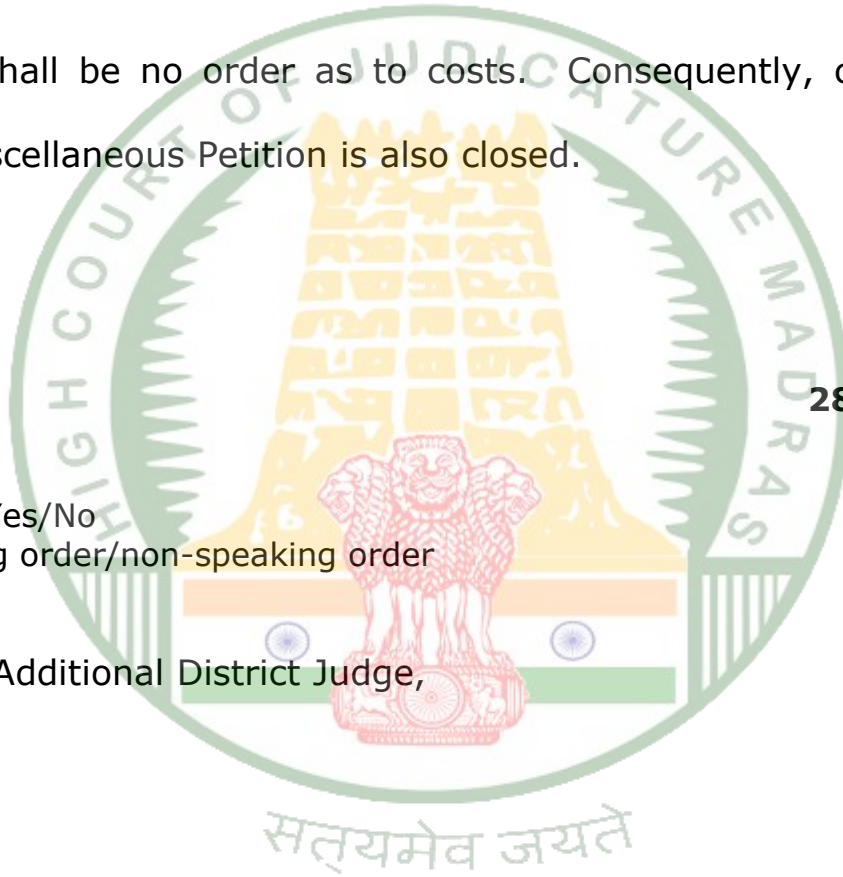
within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.

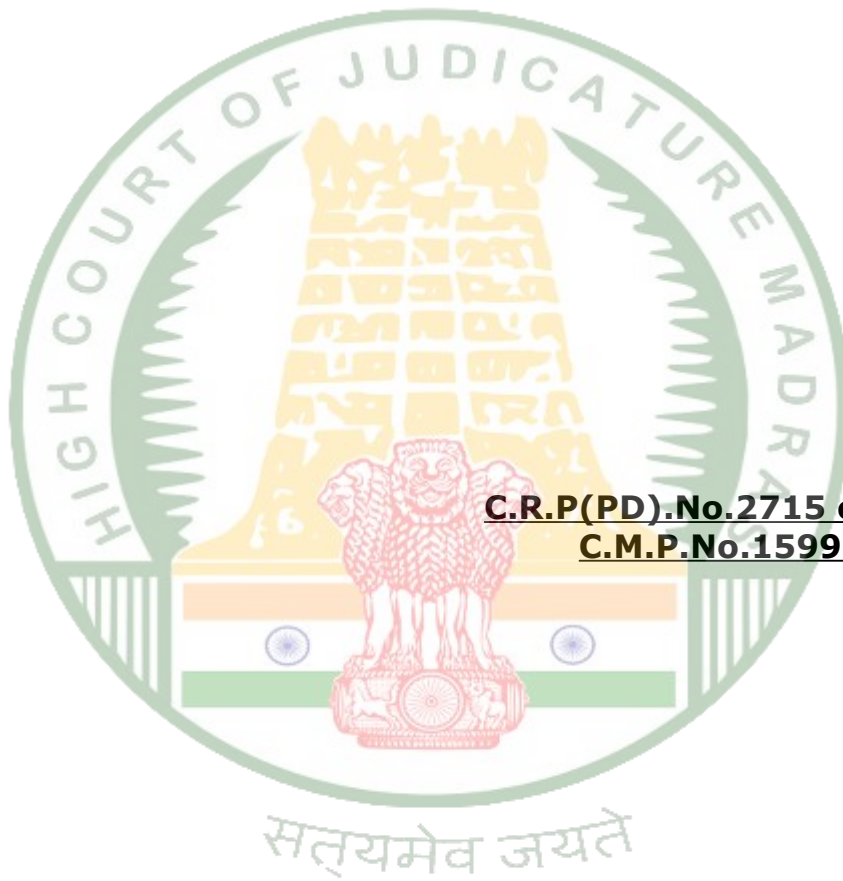
